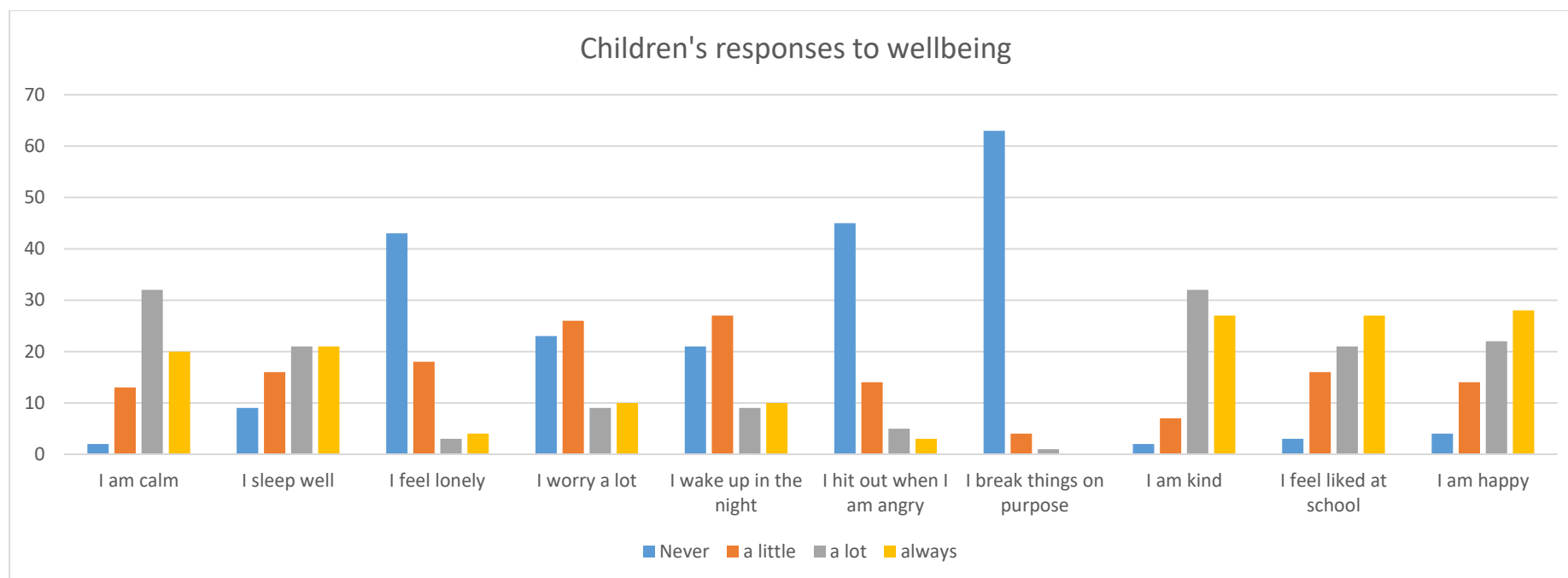
We are pleased that parent opinion of how we deal with bullying is high, however, we feel that it could be higher and will therefore develop tightened procedures by creating a new policy with clearer procedures and create a wellbeing project for our pupils.



This indicates that there are pastoral care needs in the P5 and P7 classes. These will be addressed through the Nurturing Approach to Schools programme and the new Anti-Bullying procedures.



We are pleased that children feel safe in school and generally get on with their teachers. The sense of belonging is one of the side effects of Covid and as restrictions ease, we hope to develop more of a community spirit and a sense of team. We will also be working on a children's Wellbeing project including revamping the school grounds.



We will continue to have a focus on Wellbeing and to run Nurture Groups. We will also take part in the Happy Healthy Minds project and offer counselling support for some of the children who were identified as requiring support through this survey.
