Eco-Schools Green Legacy Hiroshima Project

On Friday 23rd February our Eco-team along with St Mary's, Kircubbin's Eco-team are planning to plant two very special trees in each school's grounds. It is envisaged that the Eco-team from St Mary's Primary will travel to ourselves to plant our tree and our Eco-team will travel to St Mary's to plant their tree.

The trees are supplied by Greenmount Agricultural College as part of their Hiroshima Project.

The seeds our trees were grown from came from actual trees in a school in Hiroshima. The seeds were collected from trees that survived the devastating Hiroshima atomic bomb some 75 years ago. Seeds of the "Hibaku-jumoku" (Japanese for survivor trees) are entrusted to partner organisations in countries around the world and Greenmount Campus hav been accepted as a suitable partner and have received seeds of two tree species – the Maidenhair Tree (Ginko Biloba) and the Oriental Plane (Platanus Orientalis).

These special trees carry the double message of caution and hope, recalling both the destructive power of war but also the resilience of mankind and nature. The seedlings raised are being planted in Botanic Gardens and Colleges throughout the world as a living symbol of peace for the generations to come.

It will be an hour to have one of these trees planted in our school grounds.
